

Options for live transmission of SOTEU

Satellite reception

In order to broadcast on a TV channel, the best option is to receive the satellite broadcast (HD) as explained here:

Web broadcast

In order to broadcast on a webpage, you can directly embed the EBS+ live player:

You can choose size and language, but you have to take care about http & https settings (webmasters will know that). The embed code for EBS+ with French language and size 852x480 pixel is

The embed code for a different configuration (language / size) can be created via the EBS+ live player by clicking in the encircled area on the screenshot below.

The embed code is permanent (it will always show the current broadcast) and can thus be already pre-programmed on the target page (and turned on when the SOTEU begin). SOTEU-related broadcasts (arrivals, illustrative shots etc.) will begin as of 8.15 CET.
